What's new in Chest since December 2022

The Team at Chest negotiate preferential licence agreements for commercially available software on behalf of Jisc's members and customers. It can be used to benefit the entire institution to support academic research, teaching and learning, as well as administrative functions.

Chest software agreements include software from Microsoft and Adobe, in specialist areas such as GIS, statistics and maths, in qualitative and quantitative data analysis, mind mapping and training, and tools for software asset management and security.

Renewal News

Adobe



Negotiations with Adobe are underway for a new ETLA Agreement, to start this August and run for three years. Our current Adobe CLP Framework is due to end in May. We have agreed with Adobe to renew for two more years and are awaiting contractual paperwork to proceed.

Esri - expires 31/7/2023

esri UK A joint Jisc/Esri initiative of community updates and consultations started last summer around the upcoming renewal of the Esri Chest Agreement.

Bandings will most likely stay the same, with price increases currently under consideration. The existing products licensed will remain (and will be added to by new products), the main exception being that ArcMap/ArcGIS Desktop will be retired in March 2024. Esri is supporting those sites who are still to move their desktop users over to ArcGIS Pro. Information will be added to the Renewal News page, as and when it becomes available. We are hoping to have the new agreement in place by early May and will communicate directly with licensed institutions once it is live on the Chest website.





Examity - expires 30/4/2023

Time flies! The <u>Examity Chest Agreement</u> is fast approaching the end of its first threeyear term. Recognising the importance of Online Assessment solutions to institutions, we are working to renew this Agreement in advance of its 30 April end date. Maplesoft and Maple Learn for FE & Schools - expire 30/4/2023



Negotiations are almost complete for extending the existing <u>Maplesoft</u> and <u>Maple</u> <u>Learn for FE & Schools</u> Chest Agreements for a further five years. It is looking likely that the products and bandings will stay the same, with a pricing adjustment to accommodate the change in pricing since it was last fixed in 2018.

Updates will be posted on the <u>Renewal News page</u>, with contacts at existing licensed institutions being notified directly as soon as the new agreements are in place. Note that, under both these agreements, institutions are licensed for three years from sign-up which means that their terms and conditions and annual pricing won't change until they renew under the new agreements.

Microsoft - expires 31/12/2023

Microsoft Our current Microsoft EES Framework ends on 31 December. Negotiations for its renewal with Microsoft are due to start around Easter and we are currently gathering requirements from the community for the new agreement. We are also seeking clarity from Microsoft around their recently announced bi-annual price changes.

SAS: expires 31/7/2023



Negotiations are well underway to renew the <u>SAS Chest Agreement</u> for a tenth term. Initial impressions are that not much is likely to change compared to previous version, but until the contracts are signed nothing is confirmed.

We'll keep the <u>Renewal News page</u> updated as and when we have anything definitive to share, and once the new Agreement is in place we'll email all licence-holding institutions.

Citavi: Reference Management Solution

Citavi is an all-in-one referencing and note-taking solution, designed for individuals and teams. With Citavi you can search resources from around the world, create tasks, analyse texts, save quotations and ideas, create outlines for drafts, and write reports, articles, or books. More popular than its primary competitor in much of Europe, it's an excellent reference management solution (check out the reviews) that's well worth considering if your current solution doesn't tick all the boxes. It's also the only





reference management program for teams that gives you the option of storing your information on your own server instead of in the cloud.

The <u>Citavi Chest Agreement</u> offers heavily discounted pricing for the academic community, with unlimited site licences based on combined FTE and fixed three and five-year pricing. Citavi is brought to you by Lumivero (formerly QSR), the company behind NVivo and related products; Citavi purchases can also be bundled in with NVivo if required. Chest Agreements for EDINA Services

Over the last couple of years, Chest have worked with EDINA to put in place Agreements for their Noteable and STACKED Services.

Noteable

Noteable is a cloud-based computational notebook service which provides access to the most commonly used computational notebooks including Python and R. Notebooks available within Noteable come with a large number of libraries and extensions already set up. Noteable also comes with an autograding feature enabling teachers to set assignments for a class of learners with defined rules around automated marking of the code that the learner has written. The Noteable Chest Agreement provides both Site Licence and Per User Licence options, allowing an institution to either license use at scale or to license a cohort associated with a particular course. Testimonials of existing use across a range of disciplines can be found at the bottom of the Agreement's Product Information tab; a short Noteable User Story recording, given by a Lecturer in Programming for Business at the University of Edinburgh, is also available via EDINA's Noteable YouTube Channel.

STACKED

STACKED

<u>STACK</u> is an online assessment system for mathematics and science which accepts mathematical answers and provides sophisticated feedback. Working closely with Professor Chris Sangwin, STACK creator and Chair of the STACK International

Advisory Board, EDINA have developed <u>STACKED</u> - an up-to-date Moodle and STACK installation in a scalable, robust architecture, giving all the benefits of STACK without the administrative burden of managing a STACK/Moodle instance. The <u>STACKED Chest Agreement</u> offers an annual site licence, covering up to 50 courses at up to 1,000 users per course. Maple Learn for FE & Schools: Online tool for teaching mathematics

With over 30 years of experience of working with educators to bring software to the mathematics classroom, Maplesoft has developed <u>Maple Learn</u>, an online teaching and learning environment that puts all the visualisation, solving tools, and interactivity you want at your fingertips, while also giving you the flexibility to work through steps like you would on paper. It provides a single, familiar environment that supports and enriches how you teach, making it easy to bring the benefits of technology to your students. Oxmetrics: Econometric software for economists and business students



OxMetrics is a family of software packages providing an integrated solution for the econometric analysis of time series, forecasting, financial econometric modelling, or statistical analysis of cross-section and panel data. OxMetrics consists of a front-end program called OxMetrics, and individual application modules such as Ox, CATS, PcGive, STAMP and G@RCH.

Examples of typical tasks a user might perform are:

- Opening, browsing, saving and importing databases
- Managing and transforming databases
- Creating graphs and tables of descriptive statistics to analyse the key properties of time series
- Estimating single equation models and running model diagnostic checks with PcGive15
- Performing Automatic Model Selection with Autometrics

OxMetrics 9 was recently released, bringing a whole host of new features. Find out more.

The <u>Practice Labs Chest Agreement</u> offers a choice of Single Lab or an Unlimited Library, and named or concurrent user models, with bespoke/custom Lab or Sandbox development also available. Pricing is for a one or three-year term, with an additional discount available to Institutes of Technology who place multiple orders above a certain threshold.

QSR NVivo Suite: Qualitative Data Analysis

In addition to Citavi (see above), QSR also offers NVivo, NVivo Transcription, and NVivo Collaboration through Chest:

NVivo is the leading qualitative data analysis solution, allowing users to analyse data, discover patterns, identify themes, glean insight and draw meaningful conclusions. The <u>NVivo Chest Agreement</u> continues to





be one of the most popular Chest Agreements, offering an unlimited site licence with heavily discounted pricing banded by FTE numbers, with separate pricing for FE and HE. A new version of NVivo, V14, will be being released very soon; this new version will only offer NVivo Plus, so unfortunately NVivo Pro users will either be unable to move to the latest version, or will have to upgrade to Plus. NVivo Transcription is powerful automated transcription from QSR that gives users the freedom to focus on their analysis. The <u>NVivo Transcription Chest Agreement</u> allows institutions to purchase as many or as few hours as they'd like, to allocate as appropriate.

NVivo Collaboration comes in two flavours, Collaboration Server and Collaboration Cloud. Both simplify the process of securely sharing data, expertise, and insights across research teams. Worth noting, QSR recently merged with two other software providers, Palisade and Addinsoft, to create a new company, Lumivero. <u>Find out more about Lumivero</u>. Same product, different name, at some stage in the near future we'll be obliged to update names, logos etc.

The <u>Tanium Chest Agreement</u> was launched in the first half of last year, offering institutions a unique academic unlimited site licence for a simplified product bundle, with a choice of on premise or cloud licences. The pricing model is based on Jisc Banding, with two and three-year licences available plus the opportunity to pay annually or upfront.

Verbit serves as a one-stop-shop for all institutional transcription and captioning needs. They provide seamless integrations and real-time service at competitive pricing that doesn't compromise on accuracy or speed. They make captions not just

an accommodation feature, but a learning feature to benefit all students. Their transcriptions and captions are up to 99% accurate, and supports compliance with Public Sector Bodies Accessibility Regulations (2018) for recorded video.

The <u>Verbit Chest Agreement</u> came out in 2022, and offers <u>Captioning</u>, <u>Transcription</u>, <u>Live Captions</u> and <u>Audio Description</u>. The Agreement also offers a unique licensing model that allows institutions complete control over their spend – institutions purchase credits and then call off services as required.
