SAS Viya SAS Viya is a cloud-enabled, in-memory analytics engine that provides quick, accurate and reliable analytical insights. Elastic, scalable and fault-tolerant processing addresses the complex analytical challenges of today, while effortlessly scaling for the future.

As an integrated part of the SAS Platform, SAS Viya provides:

- Faster processing for huge amounts of data and the most complex analytics, including machine learning, deep learning and artificial intelligence.
- A standardized code base that supports programming in SAS and other languages, like Python, R, Java and Lua.
- Support for cloud, on-site or hybrid environments. It deploys seamlessly to any infrastructure or application ecosystem.

SAS Viya is also available through the SAS Chest Agreement. Institutions with a SAS licence can order Viya up to the same level for free. For example, if an institution has a Campus licence for SAS, they can also have a Campus licence for Viya at no additional cost; if they have a Department licence for SAS they are only entitled to a Department licence for Viya at no additional cost. Any institution is able to add a SAS

Viya licence to their licence or buy a SAS Viya licence at any time.

Process for ordering / implementing SAS Viya

Using the Chest/SAS Order Form, the institution should order SAS Viya v3.5 software as an add-on to its exiting SAS software stack. This stack is licensed under the Chest Agreement with SAS.

The environment within which SAS Viya is to be hosted is the institution's choice and its responsibility to acquire, install and maintain. Assuming that this is accepted, the following steps are necessary for obtaining SAS Viya:

1. Understand the [system requirements for SAS Viya](#)
 2. A MS Teams call with a SAS customer advisor to discuss technical preparation by HIC. Chest can help facilitate this.
 3. Chest/SAS Order Form completed and submitted per usual
 4. Chest will inform SAS Legal about the order
 5. In this instance NO payment is asked for SAS Viya (see these pages)
 6. SAS Legal will update its systems with the new add-on software for the institution and the appropriate passcodes will be generated
 7. SAS software download email(s) - with the SAS passcodes – will then be sent to the institution / HIC
 8. Installation of SAS Viya is done by HIC, or (for payment) by either SAS Professional Services or an approved SAS Partner.
- This whole process depends on quick responses by ALL parties and could potentially happen within a few days of being initiated.

SAS – Renewing your licence 2023

Ordering

1 August 2023 marked a brand-new SAS Chest Agreement. As such, if you require a licence for SAS you must submit a new order. Not just a PO, but an actual order. It is the order form that creates the contract between institution and software supplier, and no licence will be issued unless an order form has been submitted.

Ordering is online – on these webpages look for the green 'Order Now' button. You do need to be **registered** and logged in to place an order. **The 'How to order' page** provides some assistance with the order process.

If ordering via these SAS Chest Agreement webpages presents problems, please contact Chest Help, who can help talk you through the process.

Invoices & POs

On receipt of your order form, Chest will pass the order to SAS and arrange for your invoice to be sent. If the invoice requires a PO to be quoted, make sure you have either provided PO details on your product order form, or sent your PO separately to help@chest.ac.uk in good time. If the PO arrives after the invoice has been sent, it will take time to get the invoice amended, which may impact on your licence keys. The PO should be made out to Jisc, 4 Portwall Lane, Bristol, BS1 6NB

Licence Keys

SAS's policy is, and always has been, that they will only release licence keys once the invoice has been paid. Chest are monitoring payments and advising SAS accordingly on a regular basis. If you need your licence keys, first question is "has your invoice been paid (and the money needs to have cleared into Jisc's bank account)?" If yes, please feel free to get in touch with Chest Help, ask them to follow up with SAS.

Please note, SAS licences have 30 days' grace, so whilst for continuity and comfort's sake we would encourage you to get your invoice paid as quickly as possible, your users are not going to be impacted until the end of August.

Software distribution

There's no need for SAS to be distributed to users on discs. SAS sends the University's main SAS contact an email containing a software download link and the annual license key. Typically, this software download email is then forwarded to each user. The user then downloads the software from the SAS website using the download link.

Payment Terms

Each Licensed Site will pay to Chest an annual licence fee, plus VAT, according to the products licensed and level of licence plus an Chest Admin Fee of £350.00. Jisc will invoice Licensed Sites for the initial fee on receipt of a completed Order.

If a Site becomes licensed/licences a product(s) part way through a year, monthly pro-rating will apply. Pro-rating will **not apply** to the Chest Admin Fee. Once a Site has committed for a licence period it will be committed until the end of that period (31 July).

Please Note: SAS will not release the licence keys for SAS software until payment has been received by Jisc.

Chest is an Enterprise of Jisc. All Purchase orders must be made out to Jisc, 4 Portwall Lane, Bristol, BS1 6NB to cover all charges plus VAT.

All terms contained in a PO are expressly rejected and do not form part of the Licence or vary the Licence terms in any way.

Payments are due within thirty days of invoice date; recipients of late payments are entitled to interest in accordance with **UK statutory provisions**.

Termination Clauses

As this Agreement is running for one year only, all licences will terminate 31 July 2024. As such, there is no opt-out clause.

Location and Use Permissions

If a Department, Faculty or Campus has any users outside of the UK or Ireland who are either directly employed by the site or enrolled on a course/degree offered by a site, such users may remotely access the SAS Software installed at the Department, Faculty, or Campus subject to US and UK export control restrictions.
